



D.I.Y PHOTO GUIDE TO A BALLOON RELEASE

Using your balloon net is very simple if you follow this easy 10 step guide.



Step 1

Unravel your Balloon Net and lay it out on the floor. At one end there is a large knot, this is the top of the net, at the other end you will find it is strung together leaving a hole just large enough to insert the inflated balloons.

Step 2

Whilst you are filling the net, both ends will need to be tied off to something heavy or a fixed object such as a railing, gatepost etc. here we have tied the top end into our Van and the Bottom onto the Cylinder trolley.

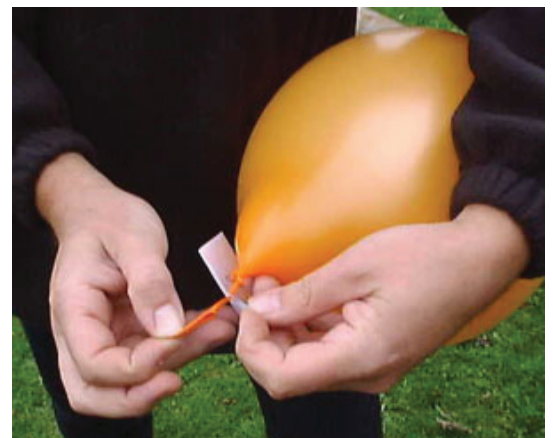


Step 3

Once your net is secure you are ready to start inflating the balloons, Place the Balloon over the nozzle and move the nozzle in any direction to release the Gas or push down if the filling kit is a pushdown type.

Step 4

Tie the balloon. If you are attaching Race Labels, pull the tied neck of the Balloon through the hole on the Race Label, you will find that the neck of Balloon holds it on.

Step 5

Insert the Balloon into the net making sure it can't escape again!



Step 6

Carry on filling Balloons until you run out of balloons.



Step 7

Once the net is filled it will need to be secured unless you are releasing the balloons immediately, once again tie off to something heavy. Here we have used the cylinder and trolley. Make sure that you leave a nice long line from the top of the net as this will be used later when releasing. Tie the net as low down as you can get it and try to keep it out of any wind that may be blowing, we have used the van as a shelter.

Step 8

When you are ready to release, untie the net and walk to the release area, the release will need to be completed by 2 people, one to hold the chord from the top of the net, and the other to release the bottom. Now is a good time to gather people together for photos.



Step 9

Make sure that the person holding the chord from the top of the net has a good grip, the person on the bottom of the net needs to cut the chord which is threading the bottom of the net together, *(Hold net to make sure balloons are not released until ready.)* Then simply let go of the bottom of the net and the balloons will escape!

Step 10

Pat yourself on the back on a job well done!
